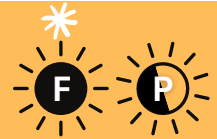

- Asclepias verticillata

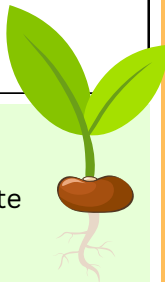
## Notes

- Growth habit: upright/clumping
- Fast-growing native perennial
- Attracts butterflies
- Thrives in sandy soils in full sun

## Propagation Information

- Seeds require 30-day cold stratification before they germinate in a warm location
- Blooms the 1<sup>st</sup> year
- Self-seeds fast and spreads by rhizomes and stolons at a medium pace
- Propagate by division in spring/fall
