Family: Araceae/Arum

Garden Companions

- Iris versicolor
- Chelone glabra
- Tiarella cordifolia
- Trillium spp.

Notes

- Growth habit: upright stalk
- Thrives in rich soils in the shade
- Think carefully about where to plant it because it does not transplant well
- Can take up to 5 years to flower
- Seeds are poisonous to humans and **sap can irritate some people's skin**
- wear gloves!

Blooms April to July



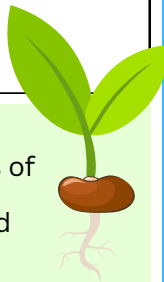
Keystone Plant Score: 1



Provides Bird Seeds/Fruit

Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate after 60-90 days of warm moisture followed by 60-90 days of cold moisture - best sowed outdoors in the spring - expect germination in 1 year
- Seeds are dispersed through bird droppings
- Spreads slowly by cormlets
