- Carex digitalis

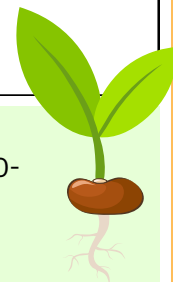
## Notes

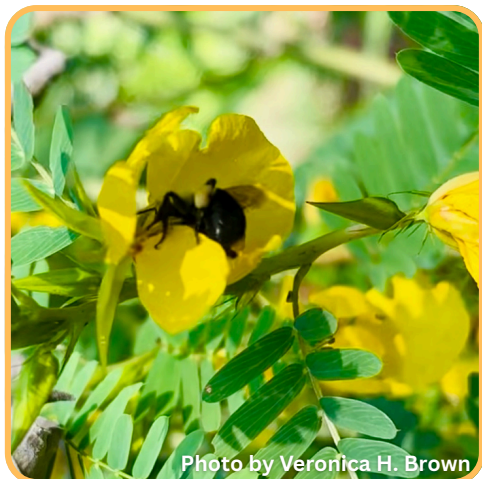
