- Attracts bees and other pollinators/wildlife

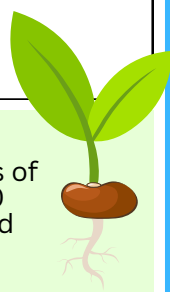

Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate after 60-90 days of warm moisture followed by 60-90 days of cold moisture - best sowed outdoors in the spring - expect germination in 1 year
- Seeds are dispersed by ants
- Spreads by underground tubbers/corms
- Propagate by root cuttings when plant is dormant in fall
