Notes

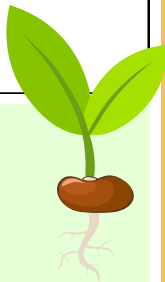
- Native to US
- Growth habit: clumping/upright
- Grows at a medium pace
- Attracts bees and butterflies
- Nectar for hummingbirds
- Finch favorite

 NOT Native to Cape Cod	 Blooms June to July
	 Caterpillar/Moth Host Plant
 Provides Bird Seeds/Fruit	 Container Friendly
	 Rarely eaten by deer

Propagation Information

- Seeds require a 90-day cold stratification period before germinating in a warm location
- Blooms in 2nd year
- Self-seeds at a medium pace
- Propagate by division in spring/fall
