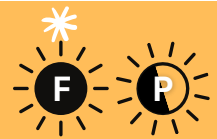

- Physostegia virginiana

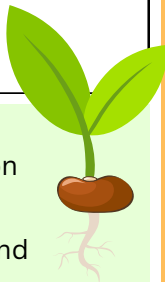
Notes

- Native to US
- Growth habit: clumping/upright
- Grows at a medium pace
- Attracts beneficial insects
- Finch favorite

Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate in a warm location without pre-treatment
- Blooming year: maybe 1st, likely 2nd
- Self-seeds fast
- Mature plant root ball can be propagate by division in spring/fall
