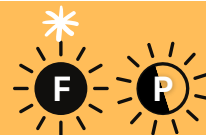

- Growth habit: vase-shaped

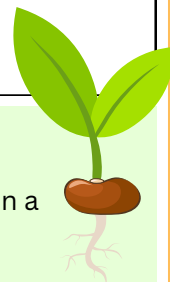

Propagation Information

- Seeds require 60-day cold stratification before germinating in a warm location
- Blooms in 1st year
- Self-seeds and spreads by rhizomes slowly
- Propagate by division in spring and fall
