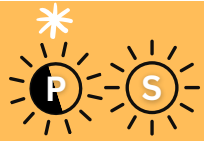

## Garden Companions

- Aquilegia canadensis
- Polygonatum biflorum
- Solidago caesia
- Geranium maculatum
- Ageratina altissima

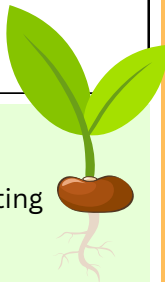
## Notes

- Growth habit:  
sprawling/mounding/spreading
- Grows at a medium pace
- Attracts beneficial insects
- Less aggressive in dry soils
- Shearing the plant to 6" in early summer produces a more compact plant

## Propagation Information

- Seeds require a period of 60-day cold stratification before germinating in a warm location
- Blooming year: may take 2-5 years
- Self seeds and spreads by rhizomes at a medium pace
- Propagate by cuttings
- Propagate by division in spring
