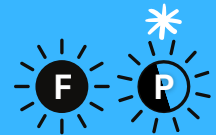

- Aquilegia canadensis
- Erythronium americanum

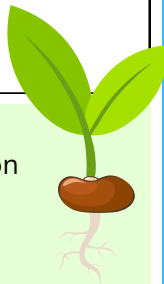
Notes

- Growth habit: clumping
- Attracts bees, butterflies, and other pollinators/wildlife
- Low-maintenance
- Easy to transplant



Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate in a warm location without pre-treatment
- Blooms in 2nd year
- Self-seeds and spreads by rhizomes slowly
- Can be propagated by division
