- Coreopsis rosea

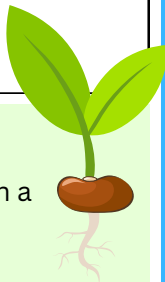
Notes

- Native to MA and New England
- Growth habit: spreading/climbing
- Fast-growing perennial vine
- Attracts bees, butterflies & hummingbirds
- Performs better in full sun
- Needs a trellis or other support structure or can be grown as a groundcover

Propagation Information

- Seeds require 30-90 days of cold stratification before germinating in a warm location
- Bloom year: 1st or 2nd
- Self-seeds slowly and spreads through stem nodes at a medium pace
- Propagate by cuttings and layering in late spring/early summer
