- Liatris spp.

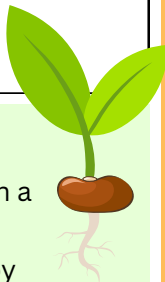
Notes

- Growth habit: spreading/suckering
- Attracts songbirds
- Low maintenance
- Thrives in full sun and dry soils

Propagation Information

- Seeds require 60-day cold stratification before germinating in a warm location
- Bloom year: maybe 1st, likely 2nd
- It readily self-seeds and spreads by rhizomes at a medium pace
- Propagate by cuttings in spring
- Propagate by division when plant is mature
