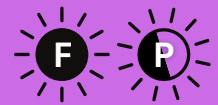

- Echinacea purpurea
- Schizachyrium scoparium
- Symphyotrichum novae-angliae

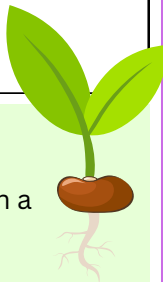
Notes

- Native to MA and New England
- Growth habit: clumping
- Attracts pollinators
- Deadhead after blooming to prevent self-seeding if you want to control spread
- Pinch flowers heads as they begin to fade and you will encourage additional blooms to emerge
- If grown in a container, it might flop and need support
- Supports native butterflies and bees at risk including Bombus Vagans

 Provides Bird Seeds/Fruit	 Container Friendly	 Preferred by imperiled native bees and butterflies

Propagation Information

- Seeds require 60-day cold stratification before germinating in a warm location
- Bloom year: maybe 1st, likely 2nd
- It self-seeds aggressively
- Propagate by cuttings
- Propagate by division in spring
