Family: Ramunculaceae/Buttercup

## Garden Companions

- Polemonium reptans
- Erythronium spp.

## Notes

- Native to MA and New England
- Growth habit: clumping
- Thrives in hummusy/acidic soil
- Low maintenance
- Attracts bees and other pollinators/wildlife
- Dies back in summer
- **Plant is toxic/use gloves!**

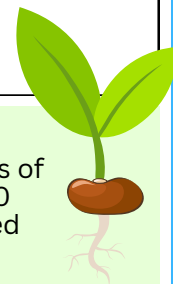

## Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate after 60-90 days of warm moisture followed by 60-90 days of cold moisture - best sowed outdoors in the spring - expect germination in 1 year
- Bloom year: 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>
- It slowly self seeds
- Propagate by root cuttings and by division
