Notes

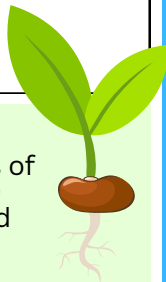
- Growth habit: spreading
- Attracts beneficial insects and wildlife
- Grows naturally in woodlands - does best in dappled shade
- Best in well-drained soil
- No information available on rabbit resistance

 Cape Cod Native	 Blooms April to May
 Caterpillar/Moth Host Plant	 Provides Bird Seeds/Fruit
 Container Friendly	 Deer Resistant


Keystone Plant Score: 1

Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate after 60-90 days of warm moisture followed by 60-90 days of cold moisture - best sowed outdoors in the spring - expect germination in 1 year
- Bloom year: 2nd or 3rd
- It self-seeds slowly and spreads by rhizomes at a medium pace
- Propagate by division in early spring or late fall
