- *Solidago speciosa*

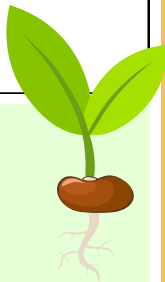
## Notes

- Growth habit: compact/clumping and shrub-like
- Slow -growing
- As a legume, it helps fix nitrogen in the soil
- Attracts bees, butterflies, and other pollinators
- Excess shade or competition from neighboring plants can inhibit growth and cause decline

## Propagation Information

- Seeds require scarification and 10 days of cold, moist stratification before germinating in a warm location
- Blooms: 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- Spreads slowly through rhizomes
- Propagate through cuttings
