- *Rudbeckia hirta*

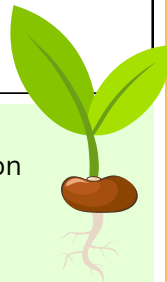
Notes

- Attracts pollinators and other wildlife
- Great for erosion control/soil stabilization
- Supports native butterflies at risk

Propagation Information

- Seeds germinate in a warm location without pre-treatment
- Spreads slowly by seeds
- Propagate mature plants through division in spring
